All Entries – Guidelines and Procedures:

1. Quilt entries must be quilted, made of fabric, finished, and in good condition. Other entries must be made of fabric, finished, and in good condition.
2. Entries must not have been entered previously in a Foothill Quilters Guild show.
3. Quilts must have a 4” sleeve attached to the top of the back of the quilt. The sleeve should end 1½” in from each side of the quilt. Contact Gail Reinke if a sleeve is not practical for your entry.
4. Entries must be free of odors and debris.
5. The paper label provided on the top right of this page must be sewn to the item back on the lower right side. Please sew the label inside garments. Please use only paper labels (also available on our website).
6. Preference will be given to FQG members. Non-member entries will be accepted on a “space available” basis. If necessary, FQG reserves the right to decline the entry based upon membership standing or the number of items entered. You will be notified if your entry is declined.
7. Non-judged entries must be hand delivered with label and sleeve sewn on, **Thursday, April 2, 2020 between 8:30am and 9:30am to the gym at ARD Regional Park, Richardson Dr., Auburn CA.**
8. Notify Gail Reinke at 530-613-1975 immediately if one or more of your entries must be withdrawn from the show or if you are unable to deliver your quilt at the specified date and time.
9. **Entries must be picked up Saturday, April 4, 2020 between 5pm and 6pm at the gym at ARD Regional Park. You must present your receipt to claim your entries.**
10. Quilt/item can be for sale, all sales transactions are between the seller and buyer. Remit a \$5 handling fee with your entry. (Maximum of 4)

Judged Entries:

1. Judging will take place **at the Auburn Airport in the Barnstormer room.** Judged entries must be hand-delivered between **8:30am and 9:30am on Wednesday, April 1, 2020.** The Judging Committee will secure quilts for hanging on Thursday.
2. Judged entries must include \$8 per item entered for judging. Make checks payable to FQG.
3. The judge must be able to view the back of the quilt.

4. Judging will be conducted using the “elimination method.”
5. A scribe will be assigned to each judge who will record comments of the judges. The comments will be returned to the exhibitor at the close of the show.
6. Entries will be judged anonymously.
7. Judging will be open for observation to all.
8. The judging committee reserves the right to move an entry to a different category or return the judging fee if the entry cannot be judged fairly.
9. Remember, if your quilt is professionally quilted, please indicate 2-person quilt and list all participants.

Category Definitions:

- ◆ **PIECED:** Piecing predominates over applique or other technique either in amount or effect.
- ◆ **APPLIQUE (HAND OR MACHINE):** Applique predominates over piecing or other techniques in either amount or effect.
- ◆ **INNOVATIVE:** The use of materials that are not normally used in a art quilt or a unique presentation.
- ◆ **TRADITIONAL:** Based on traditional style patterns.
- ◆ **MODERN:** Emphasizes simplicity, minimalism, and/or asymmetrical designs.
- ◆ **PICTORIAL:** Represents a recognizable image of a person, place or thing; may be whole cloth, painted, applique, collage or any number of techniques.
- ◆ **ART:** Extends beyond the traditional and innovative disciplines, using personal expression and originality in design, color or technique.
- ◆ **MINIATURE:** Miniature versions of large quilt. All parts of the quilt should be in proportion; ie, piecing, quilting borders, binding. Quilts should be no larger than 24”x24”.
- ◆ **2020 FQG CHALLENGE:** “Inspiration”.
- ◆ **WEARABLE:** Fashionable and wearable garment constructed using quilting techniques.
- ◆ **OTHER:** Whole Cloth, Embroidery, Bags, Fiber art, Creative etc. (describe).

Have you included for each entry?

- ◆ **Completed entry form, including required measurements and colors.**
- ◆ **Color photograph of the entry.**
- ◆ **Color photograph of the quilter/quilters.**
- ◆ **Signature on the Waiver.**
- ◆ **\$8 judging fee if the entry is to be judged.**
- ◆ **\$5 handling fee for each “for sale” entry.**
