We will be using Jane's **Blue Lupin** collage pattern provided at class.

Optional: In the workshop we will add paint on the neutral background. I will provide Intense blocks or pencils, fabric and/or acrylic paints, and supplies to do this.



Blue Lupine Fabric Collage

You will need:

- Neutral background approximately 12" x 16" or larger, which can be muslin, duck cloth, linen, or canvas in cream- or light-colored cotton.
- Variety of fabrics from scraps to small pieces in a variety of greens and purples. It works well to include different values and patterns that can be fussy cut.

Fabric Collage Tools:

- Pencil,
- Chalk marking tool or disappearing pen (Frixion). I like the Bohin chalk marker.
- Fabric glue with fine nozzle or glue applicator. I use Aleene's Original Tacky Glue
- Good, sharp small scissors (I use Karen Kay Buckley 6" scissors)
- Optional: Lightbox. Battery powered to work in the classroom
- Optional: Tweezers
- Optional: Sewing machine & basic sewing supplies. If time allows some of you may be able to start machine applique of the design or thread play and eventually quilting.

Not needed for class but to finish the project.

Border fabric, batting, backing fabric and binding.
