

Modern Cathedral Windows By Marylee Drake Supply List

To make a sample Modern Cathedral Windows block about 10"x10" (size of a potholder):

- About 100 2.5-inch squares of cotton fabric. Have a nice selection of colors with some contrast
- About a fat quarter of backing
- About a fat quarter of batting
- Another FQ for the binding
- This will be more fabric than you'll need but it gives you some design options as you go along
- Thread
- Wonder clips or pins
- Stiletto
- Iron and iron mat
- Cutting mat, rotary cutter, scissors
- Sewing machine
- General sewing supplies
- Graph paper (don't buy, I'll share)
- Pen/pencil

Here are some additional instructions, 4/28/22:

- Each block takes twenty 2.5 inch squares. The little sample has 4 blocks. So $20 \times 4 = 80$ squares to make the project.
- There are twelve 2.5 inch squares of focus fabric.
- 14 inch square focus fabric for backing
- a 14 inch square of batting.
- A fabric for binding.

Marylee suggests that the students pick out a focus fabric and coordinating fabric for the "petals". You can cut them all before class and be ready to go. She would suggest cutting more than you need and maybe we can trade fabrics. Her sample has a light background which she likes, but next time she would use several lights in the background for variety.
