Location: Auburn Airport Community Room

Purpose: Learn 4 ways to make a Lemoyne star including hand and machine piecing, drafting, paper piecing and use of your custom templates and purchased rulers.

This is a technique class. You may assemble your finished stars in any way you choose. No pattern is supplied.

Supplies:

- Sewing machine, neutral 50 weight thread (gray, beige or brown to coordinate with your fabric. I like Aurifil.
- Extra sewing machine needles 60x8, microtex (I will have a few if you don't have this size)
- Snips
- Rotary cutter, new blade and accurate ruler (a small ruler - 6x12 is plenty big enough)
- Needle and thimble (if you use one)
- Seam ripper
- 4 coordinating fat quarters with some contrast
- Compass with sharp pencil
- Pencil, notebook

We will supply:

- Ironing boards
- Cutting mats (but bring a small one if you are used to using them at your work place)
- Best Press
- Template plastic
- Drafting paper
- Commercial ruler (for demonstration)
