

Exploring Free Motion Quilting by Jane Haworth **Discovery Day July 8th 2017** at Whistle Stop Quilt Shop, Auburn

Explore free motion quilting using different techniques by making small samples. These will then be trimmed and made into a collage that can later be embellished with fancy stitches and embroidery. You will work on a theme and use various fabrics in plain colors, small prints and one large scale print to create a unified collage. Your theme could be flowers, shells, owls, birds, fish, spirals, or similar, be inspired by your focus fabric.

Materials list

Variety of fabrics (at least 10 pieces) that can be as small as 8" x 8". Include dark, mediums and light tones, small prints and one large focus print.

Threads to match your color theme.

Bring hand made papers, book pages, lace, textured fabrics or other embellishments that go with your theme.

Bring small line drawings or print out copyright-free simple vintage line drawings that go along with your theme; these can be used for stitching inspiration.

Sewing machine with free motion foot.

Scissors, pins, and other basic sewing supplies.

Batting for the quilt collage (can be small pieces).
