

Discovery Day August 25/26

Tuffet for your Tootsies!

Supplies Required:

1. One tuffet kit to be ordered by the July meeting for \$86 plus shipping. The cost of shipping will be collected on the day of class. Please indicate the color of the feet – dark or light wood!
2. Interfacing will be provided at the class for another small fee to cover the material cost.
3. For fabric, it's best to bring a jelly roll, and you will use about half of it (half of each strip of that half) plus one fat quarter for the center button cover and the bottom of the tuffet. If you make your own 2½" strips, bring about 32-33 of them plus a 5 inch piece to cover the button.
4. Purchase 2 packages of upholstery nails at Home Depot. We will have tools to nails these in.
5. Thread, scissors, pins, sewing machine, cutting board and rotary cutter.
6. The kit contains: plywood round, drilled and sanded with tee nuts and commercially installed; 6"x18" beveled foam round (furniture cushion grade); 36" square of upholstery fiber (batting); 4 bun feet with installed hanger bolts, 2½" button with precut tufting cords and a gathering cord.
7. Task light – optional. The lighting in the new Airport meeting room is much better than the Bernhard Museum lighting was.
