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Orange Peel Ragtime Quilt



This pattern is based on the Orange Peel and Robbing Peter to Pay Paul patterns that date back to the early 1800's. The pattern looks complicated with all of its interlocking circles, but it is actually quite easy using the frayed -circle technique. This quilt is fun for the beginning quilter and satisfying for experienced quilters.

Orange Peel Ragtime Supply List

Fabric;

1 3/8 yds. each of 2 coordinating flannel prints for center-section top circles and backing and front arcs

1 3/8 yds. Each of 2 coordinating flannel prints for inner-border top circles and backing front arcs.

1 3/8 yds. Each of 2 coordinating flannel prints for outer-border top circles and backing front arcs.

Tools:

Template plastic 1 sheet at least 8" x 15"

Water-soluble marker or chalk pencil

Matt and rotary cutter, scissors

Omnigrd ruler

Pins, Thread

Sewing machine
